**Course Objective**  
 This course provides students with opportunity to acquire Japanese skills of lower beginner level. Through the grammar and vocabulary instruction and practice, basic skills (i.e., speaking, writing, listening, reading, listening) are introduced. Kanji is also introduced and the kanji class aims at developing basic kanji skills especially focused on kanji vocabulary and their readings.
