Course Objective
 This class aims to acquire the ability to understand general matters and abstract themes written in Japanese of intermediate level. Students are expected to learn language knowledge such as vocabulary and grammar, and at the same time express one's opinion and obtain new knowledge and information from Japanese materials.
 - Students will learn intermediate Kanji found in daily life such as social articles found in newspapers.
 The Kanji class is especially focused on kanji vocabulary and their readings.
